Advice for parents and carers on common winter bugs and viruses

With lots of common winter bugs and viruses circulating at the moment, the NHS in Gloucestershire, including the Paediatric consultant team, has developed advice for parents and carers of children to help care for them at home or know when health advice may be needed.

There is understandable concern amongst the public following reports of children and young people with Strep A or Scarlet Fever going on to develop serious illness. However, health leaders are reassuring people that Scarlet Fever is usually a very mild illness that can be easily treated with antibiotics, and it is very rare for children to go on to develop the more serious illness known as invasive group A strep (iGAS). Milk at School

As most of you will know, once children reach the age of 5, they are no longer entitled to free school milk. If you still wish your child/children to have milk at school, and they are now 5 or over, visit the Coolmilk website to register safely online; simply visit <u>Cool Milk - the UK's leading school and nursery milk supplier</u> and select 'register my child for school milk'. Children over (or approaching) age 5 can still enjoy their school milk for around £16 a term once their free entitlement ends.

Before and After School Wraparound Care

Before and After School Care fees are charged to your child's parentpay account. Please ensure these balances are cleared by the end of each month or if you are now paying via any of the nursery voucher schemes please let us know so that we can allocate your funds to your child's parentpay account. If you're paying by Edenred voucher and you need our registration number, it is **P21336066.** Many thanks.

Please keep an eye on your children's parent pay balances and top up when necessary. Please if possible make sure any outstanding dinner balances are cleared each week, or load up the balance in advance which is the preferred way.
